



Background

 Acquackanonk
- John Bradbury bought land on the Third River in 1692
- Between then and 1708, he built the first iteration of the house
- Map shows North jersey, 1700








Current Issues

- Lease expiration 8/2021
 - Cannot get most grant funding without minimum 15-year lease
 - Met with Commissioner Tucci in August, sent formal request for extension this week
- Roof
 - Currently a failing cedar shake roof, from 2002
 - Need to determine plans for replacement
 - Best course of action is to do a direct replacement
- Basement Moisture
 - Need to replace fans
